## SCHOOL CENSUS - Thursday 16th May Reception, Class 1 and 2

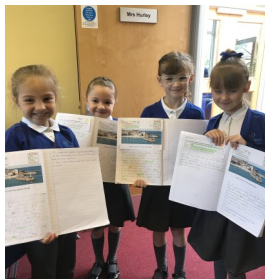
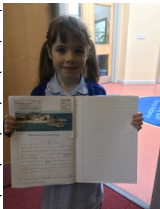
Please, please, please, **support our school** by encouraging your child to have a school dinner on Census Day (Thursday 16th May)!!
