Invent a new planet for Bob to visit. Describe where it is and what it looks like.

History & Geography

Find out about Neil Armstrong and his life. Record key facts to create a leaflet. e.g. When and where was he born? What did he do before he was an astronaut? Why is he so famous? What is the most famous thing Armstrong ever said? When did he die and how old was he?

Find out who was on the mission? What was the name of their space craft? Who walked on the Moon? How do we know they were on the Moon? How do you think Neil Armstrong felt as he walked on the Moon for the first time?
