Science:

We have been looking at different types of pollution in class over the term and started to look at some different natural disasters to have happened over time. Write a newspaper report about one of these as if you were reporting on it at the time, give it a headline and talk about the impact it had.

Some examples of these could be the Sea Empress Oil Spill in Pembrokeshire in 1996 or the big BP Oil Spill off the coast of Mexico. You could also look at disasters such as Chernobyl with chemical radiation polluting the area to an extent that it will never be safe to be exposed to during generations to come.

To ensure you get relevant information please make sure after any searches you add 'KS2' to your search entry.
